The Inland Empire Healthcare Education Consortium awards are for students who are enrolled in a nursing or healthcare program whose school is an active member of the Inland Empire Healthcare Education Consortium.

The goal of the Inland Empire Healthcare Education Consortium Award is to encourage and support students to pursue their career in the healthcare field.

Eligibility criteria

Please read the award requirements before completing this application packet.

- Be a U.S. citizen (born or naturalized), national or lawful permanent resident.
- Be admitted or enrolled in a nursing program at a school active with the Inland Empire Health Care Education Consortium (the school must be an active member in good standing).
- Maintain excellent academic record, cumulative GPA 3.2 or above.
- Demonstrate leadership qualities with peers and professionals (as identified by recommendation letters).
- Participates in ongoing programs/organizations in their school, professional organizations and/or community service. (Community service outside of school or coursework requirements)
- Demonstrates professional writing ability.
- Letter from School and/or Community served

The following items must be included in your award application packet:

- Completed and signed application form.
- Personal statement essay, addressing how you currently exemplify a healthcare leadership role in the community and/or professional organization. What contributions are you currently providing to the healthcare profession or your community? Two pages maximum, 6th edition APA format.
- Minimum of two letters of recommendation from your Nursing/allied healthcare department, community or service organization. Letter of recommendation required from service organization of >50 service hours. For less than 50 community service volunteer hours: student is to submit letter describing how community hours were spent; include an outline of how hours were spent for multiple projects, if applicable. **(Community service hours outside of school/coursework)**
- Nursing/healthcare program certification letter with GPA.
- Current resume (include names, addresses and contact information for community service activities)
- The submission packet must include all of these items.
- Must meet deadline for submission: July 1st, 2020.

Failure to include any of the above items will result in your application not being processed.

Scholarships will be evaluated by the Inland Empire Consortium Awards Committee.
